<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Staff</li> </ul> <p>The December 10 Advent Lessons and Carols service was enjoyed; there are plans to offer the service again next year.</p> <p>St. Odilia's received a generous donation. With part of the money from that donation, a used piano was purchased for the piano room.</p> <p>Endowment Funding:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fr. Rask is interested in new processional candles. There are several reasons for new candles, including the need to have candles that are easier for children to carry.</li> </ul> <p>We are considering purchasing an ambry (display case to store sacred oils).</p> <p>Attendance at the 6:00 P.M. Sunday Mass is growing; especially on nights with Confirmation events when 400-500 attend:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There is need for additional support for this Mass beyond the youth/teens; e.g. need for adult ushers and other adult support roles.</li> </ul> <p>Planning for Lent, so far, includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Friday evening Stations</li> <li>The last Friday of Lent: a Lenten Taize Prayer</li> <li>Mid-March: a Mass for Peace instead of Stations.</li> <li>Laurie asked how events for Lent would be communicated to St. Odilia's Members. Mari reported that a brochure, the web page and the bulletin would be the communication methods.</li> </ul>	Mari

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <b>Old Business</b>            Osvaldo reported that the Our Lady of Guadalupe celebration was a success; Mari reported that the event was well organized and coordinated with the Parish.             Mari shared copies of pictures of the free-standing literature stand that will be constructed.             Mari distributed copies of the wording Ana prepared for the St. Odilia Artwork brochure. Ana and Mari will work to finalize the brochure; pictures of the art will be included.         </li> <li> <b>New Business</b>            Endowment Fund: Mari said the designated funds for Worship were approved: gospel book (already done), Mass server robes, candle holders. Both large kiosks have been approved and we have the go ahead for construction; efforts were combined with Faith Formation.             Long Range Planning Survey: Report provided by Mari; she serves on this committee and also chairs the subcommittee for Worship. The intent was to obtain a broad mix of representation, including the Spanish subcommittee. The recommendations go to the Parish Leadership Council.             Lector book challenges: Ramona brought up the challenge for lectors reading from both the lectionary and then the special binder for announcements and petitions. During Mass, it is less risky to just read from the special binder; thus, avoiding the risk of the lectionary not being opened at the right place when it is time to lector during Mass. Also, the lectors are often challenged when the readings in the lectionary have a different look (e.g. spacing) than the reading the lectors receive in the mail (to read ahead/practice). Mari suggested a solution: future readings sent to the lectors would be copies of the actual readings from the lectionary.         </li> </ul>
