Where and when does your family usually complete your Family Formation lessons?

- Kitchen Table (9 responses). On Wednesday (4), On Sunday after dinner (3), On Tuesday (1)
- Dining Room on Wednesday evenings.
- Weekday evening in bedroom.
- Near our prayer center in the hallway on Wednesday evenings.
- We always pray at meals and at bed time, and try to discuss our day, as well as our family faith "topic" over dinner. We complete the "lessons" on Sunday afternoons, as it's our day to focus on God.
- We sit around the dining room table together and do our lessons on different days each week.
- Over dinner with other families.
- We complete our lessons at our great room countertop, which is the center of our daily life on Wednesdays or another day if we get too busy for Wednesday.
- We complete our lessons in the kitchen on Sundays. We bring out a portable prayer center on a wooden tray and complete our lessons.
- In our family room on Wednesday evenings.
- On Saturday mornings in our Family Room.
- We usually complete the lessons on Friday evenings. Typically there is no homework and it is nice and quiet.
- We typically do our lessons at the dining room table on Sunday afternoons, but have also taken the lessons to the cabin on a weekend to complete.
- We have completed lessons that involve listening to a DVD in the car on a trip.
