## 5144.2 Lunchroom Behavior

---

### 1.0 Policy Statement

- 1.1 Rules of conduct in the lunchroom exist to foster thoughtfulness and consideration of others and bring order to the school environment.

### 2.0 Definitions

### 3.0 Procedure

- 3.1 Teachers will accompany Kindergarten through fifth grade students into the lunchroom.
- 3.2 Students should hang their coat on the hooks (when available) in and adjacent to the lunchroom to avoid eating while in their coats.
- 3.3 Manners and order in the lunchroom should be emphasized and regarded as part of instruction.
- 3.4 Students will be allowed to go to the lavatory individually, but must ask a lunchroom supervisor first. There should never be groups of students in the lavatories during lunch time.
- 3.5 All tables and areas around tables should be left in a presentable manner.
- 3.6 Tables of students in grades K-5 are to be dismissed one at a time. All students needing a longer eating time will be allowed to remain for a length of time that is considered reasonable for the given student and circumstances.
- 3.7 Supervisory personnel in the lunchroom should not allow students to leave the lunchroom for the playground, before the scheduled recess time.
- 3.8 End of Lunch/Recess Hour: After the lunch recess, each classroom teacher (grades K-5) will meet his/her students at the northwest door (Door #3) to accompany them back to the classroom.
