

Project: *Wire Sculpture*

6th/7th Grade

Goal: Using metal wire, re-create an object by forming its contour lines and utilizing wire attachment techniques.

Craftsmanship (10 pts total)	Artist has created a piece of work using the tools required of the medium (wire, pliers). The composition is well thought out, neat, and looks like a finished piece. (10-7 pts)	Artist has created a piece of work using some of the tools required of the medium. Finished product might not look finished or neat. (6-4pts)	Artist barely used or did not use the tools required of the medium to create a piece of work. Product does not look finished and is very messy. (3-0pts)
Technique (10 pts total)	Artist's wire sculpture looks very similar to the original object. They replicated the major contour lines with wire and used at least 3 wire attachment techniques. (10-7 pts)	Artist's wire sculpture looks kind of similar to the original object. They mostly replicated the major contour lines with wire but could still add lines to make it more apparent. They used less than 3 attachment techniques. (6-4 pts)	Artist's wire sculpture barely or does not look similar to the original object. They barely or did not replicate the major contour lines with wire and used 1 or less wire attachment techniques. (3-0 pts)
Effort/ Participation (10 pts total)	Artist participates and has used class time wisely and efficiently to create a work of art that meets the objectives for the project. (10-7pts)	Artist mostly uses his/her class time wisely. Has to be reminded to get to work or stay on task. (6-4 pts)	Artist rarely uses class time to work on art. Does not participate or seem to be interested in class. (3-0 pts)
