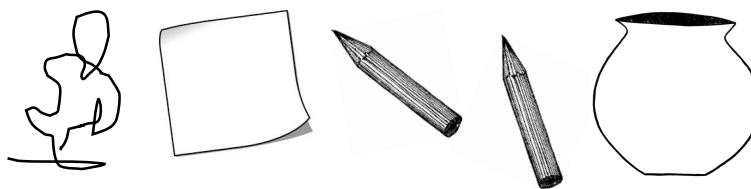


# Sculpture



Welcome to Sculpture! In this class, you will develop basic foundational skills in sculpture building using wire, cardboard, clay, and other materials. We will have 4 main projects and other small assignments throughout the class.

## Materials You Will Need:

- A folder
- Sketchbook (Any brand)
- Pencil box to store tools
  - Scissors
  - Needle Nose Pliers
- Old T-shirt that can get dirty

## Projects & Assignments:

Project	Description	Due Date
Henry Moore inspired Foam sculpture (30 pts)	Create an abstract sculpture inspired by artist, Henry Moore, using a foam block and clay tools. <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2tMYV8AuDw4">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2tMYV8AuDw4</a>	Feb. 23
Wire Sculpture (30 pts)	Bring in an object. Draw the contour lines of your object in your sketchbook. Use those contour lines as a basis for your wire design.	Mar. 30

	Your wire design should replicate the form of your object.	
Cardboard landmarks/monuments (30 pts)	Pick a national/international landmark or monument. Replicate it using various cardboard pieces, glue, and paint.	Apr. 27
Clay box/score and slip (50 pts)	Create a 4-sided box with a lid out of clay using the score and slip method. Add textures to the outside of the box using clay tools. Additive & subtractive.	May 25
